

FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES OF NORTH IDAHO

VEHICLE POLICY

When transporting clients, all employees and agents of Family Support Services will adhere to the following requirements:

- Will provide the agency, on a yearly basis, proof of liability insurance, and;
- Will provide the agency with current and valid driver license, and;
- Will inform the agency of any infraction, and;
- Will maintain safety standards on their vehicle by having yearly routine check-ups, and;
- Will respect traffic and vehicular transportation laws as set forth by the Idaho Department of Transportation, and;
- Will not drive under the influence of illegal drugs, alcohol or prescribed medication that could cause drowsiness.

Clients do have the option to receive transportation related to their services and treatment plans. In the event that a provider is authorized to transport a client we request that the legal guardian sign the quarterly release of liability. This form and a copy are presented at the beginning of services and every 4 months (120 days) thereafter.
